ABOUT US

Link Associates started as a grassroots organization in Des Moines in 1953 when a small group of parents banded together to seek opportunities for their children with intellectual disabilities. What started as one program in a church basement has today grown to become Link Associates, serving more than 680 people in 10 separate and distinct services and emplopying 300. Link Associates has a long-strong-proud history of supporting lowans with intellectual disabilities. Over the years we have made many changes with all of the additions in funding and service delivery. Link has affected the lives of thousands, by providing support and services to individuals and their family members.

- 1953 Initially known as Polk County Association for Retarded Children
- 1988 name changed to Polk County Association of Retarded Citizens (ARC)
- 1989 disaffiliated with national and state chapters of the ARC name changed to Polk County Association for Retarded People (Polk County ARP)
- 1992 changed its name to Link Associates.

Link Associates provides broad array of services, individually tailored to meet each person's and their families need. The people we serve can be in multiple services or just participate in one. To be eligible for services, each person must have a diagnosis of intellectual disability and often have other mental/medical and/or physical disabilities as well. The people who choose our services have a dramatic range of abilities and Link's staff of over 300 professionals, works side-by-side with each to them achieve their personal goals.

Without question the heart of the services we provide are the staff of Link, Working together they are the lifeline to the people we support and their families.




